Born in Lebanon to Presbyterian missionaries

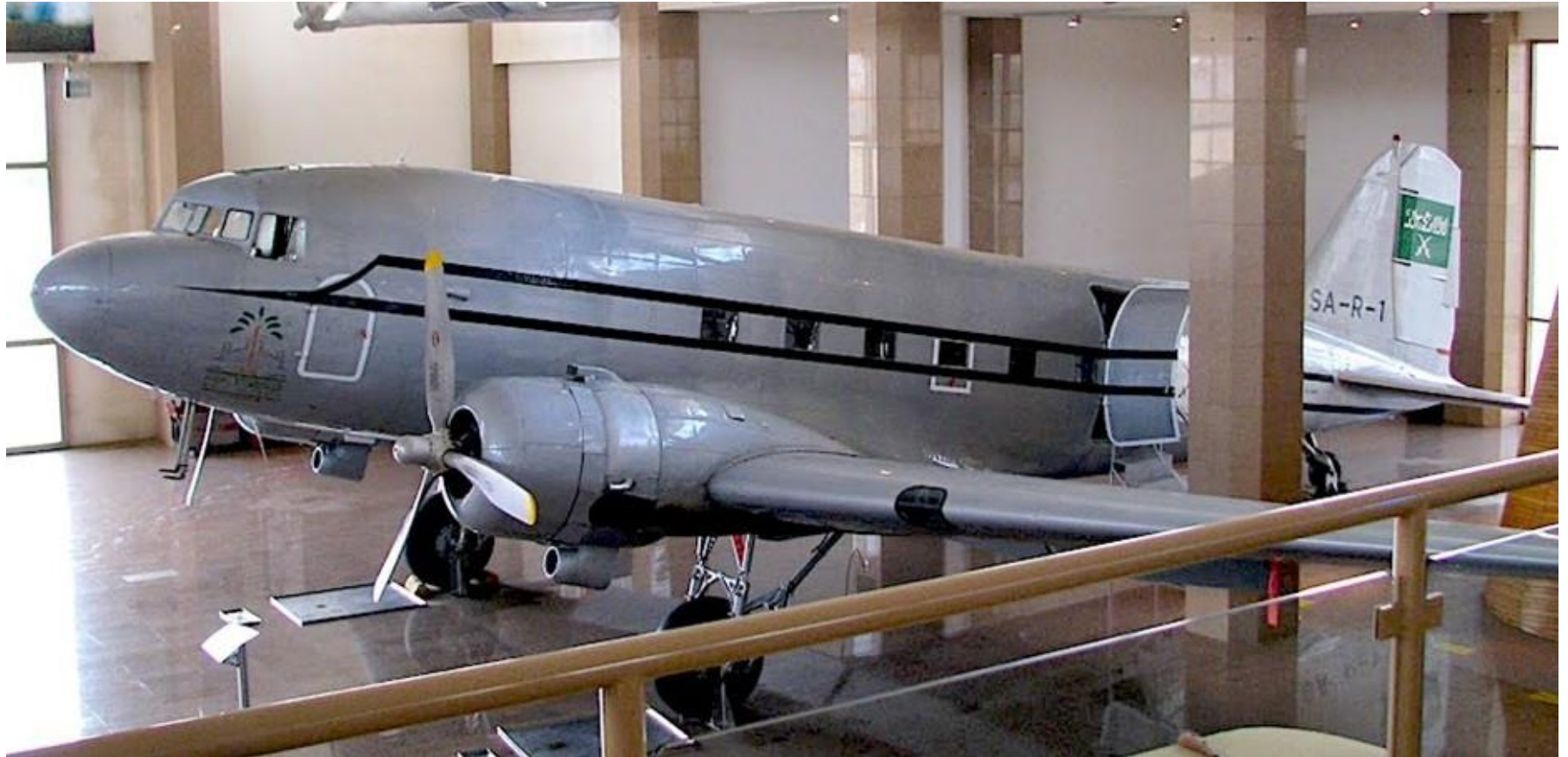
Graduated Princeton. Fought in WWI, WWII
