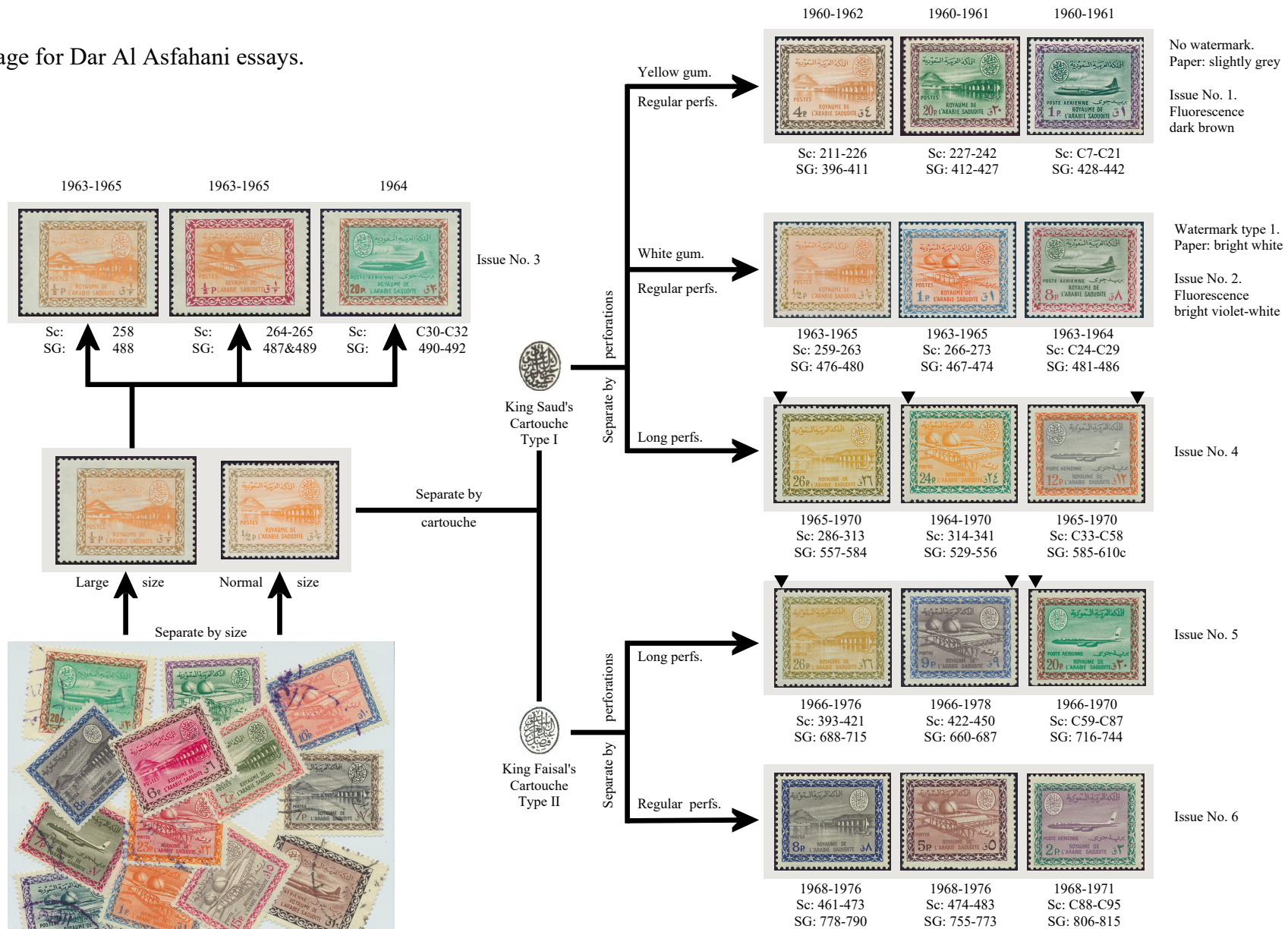


DGA Identification Guide

The chart below first appeared in Random Notes #30 but that used the old Scott catalogue numbers; these have been updated to the 2024 edition numbers. The Stanley Gibbons numbers have not changed. Note that this guide is for issued perforated stamps but it can be used for imperforates.

Mayo lists three stamps, all on unwatermarked paper:

| 1025W | 8p orange & black (figure 1) |
| 1025X | 8p blue & orange |
| 1025Y | 8p burgundy & black (figure 2) |

These stamps are distinctive and not often seen; they are not likely to cause a problem with the identification of DGA stamps.
