# WAK – Preliminary Work on Overprint Forgeries 2003 - 2005

During this period Willie King made a start on a new forgery manual for overprints. The overprints studied were mainly the Hejaz 'unframed Hashemite' and the 'framed Hashemite' overprints. The work produced could be described as the gold standard for such a work, but is totally impractical considering the resources available today.

The source files for these documents were found on Willie's computer and are now in safe hands.

It is important that this legacy is not lost as it is still relevant and a possible location for it is as a series of appendices in the new forgery manual.

# Forgery Manual Overprint forgeries

#### 1921 UNFRAMED OVERPRINT

### Forgery Type: FB-02





Above: Type FB-02 Forgeries

A scarce and rather crude forgery which is listed second since it should be eliminated easily having the same key 'fault' as FB-01.

### Key Points for Identification.

- 1. Small dot under "taa marbutah" of hukumah". This never exists in genuine overprints.
- 2. The "alif" in "hashemiyah" slants to the left.
- 3. Unusually shaped Arabic "3" in left date.
- 4. Only one or two lines at top instead of more normal 3.

Note: If only latter two points then compare with genuine position 34 shown above the forgery.

Dealers Marks: Three of the four mint stamps in the APAI collection have the tiny A.P. mark.



Observation: Previously listed as APA Forgery Type 2 so number unchanged.

- ☐ A quite scarce unframed forgery but easy to identify if looking for a dot under "taa marbutah" of hukumah".
- ☐ Please check the back we would be interested if more 'A.P' marks are found.
- ☐ Appears to be mainly targeted at the surcharge varieties
- ☐ Found on used stamps see one on piece overleaf.
- ☐ No multiples recorded. .



## The Fallibility of Catalogues

### A STAMP ISSUE

COMMEMORATING THE FIRST CONFERENCE

OF THE GULF POSTAL ORGANIZATION

At the initiative of the State of Qatar, members from the postal administrations of the Arab Gulf States gathered in Doha for discussing the establishment of a Gulf Postal Organization. Subsequently, a meeting was held in Riyadh on the month of Shawwal, 1397 AH (October, 1977), and the foundation of the Gulf Postal Organization was declared, with the city of Riyadh as the permanent head-quarters of this organization.

The organization then held its first conference in Baghdad, Iraq, on 1398 AH (1978).

Celebrating the occasion, the Directorate-General of Posts in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia issued a commemorative stamp of 20 and 50 Halalas denominations.

The 2024 issue for World Health Day was released as a sheetlet of three supposedly identical stamps but notice how the background colour changes from chalky blue at left to a deep slate-violet at right.

Notice also the variable contamination of white areas with blue. All three stamps differ. Was it designed this way or is the printing a mess?

### 1968 Jeddah to Dammam Highway



When viewed under the microscope we see another picture. The dots have been added by hand on top of the genuine printed dots.




Neat forgery with printed green dot clearly visible.

**REVISED STAMP DUES REGULATIONS:** Fixed and proportional stamps are to be consolidated, and their face values are to be considered as a basis for accepting documents whether these documents were originally subject to fixed, proportional, or road stamps so long as the object is the affixture of stamps and the collection of their value without differentiation among them.


Three fragments of contracts follow, the tax required being 5 riyals general documentary fee and 10 halalahs road tax.
