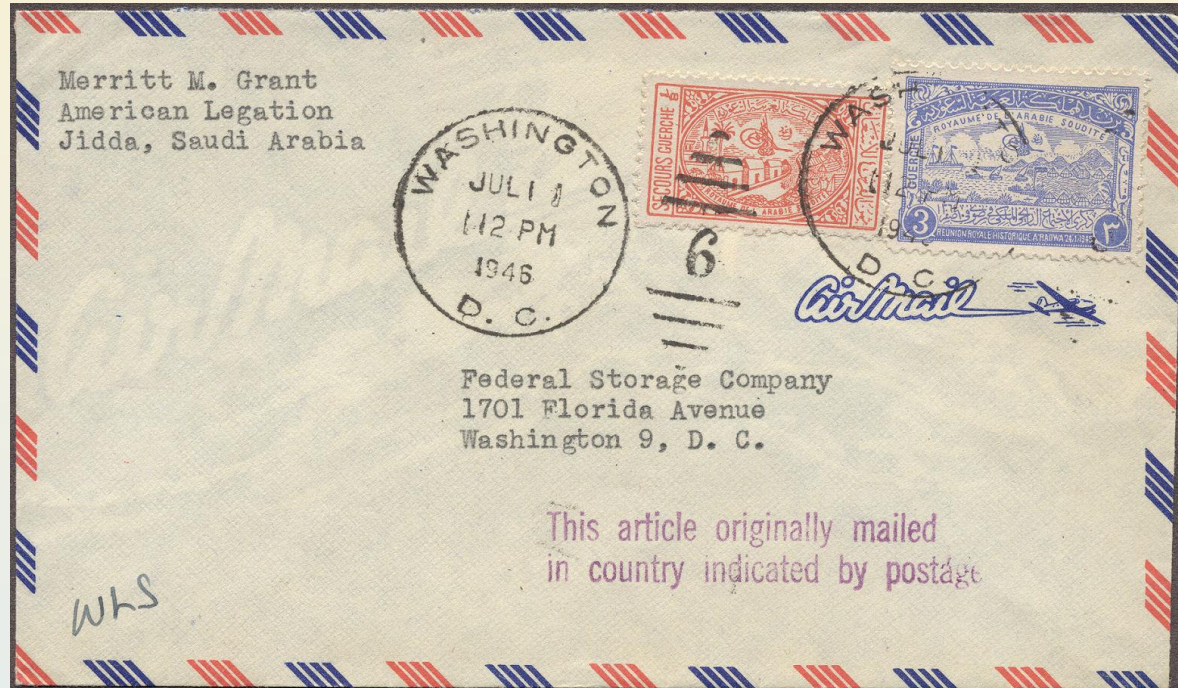

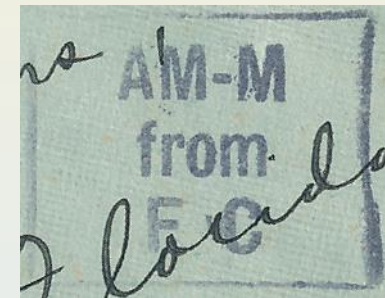
Diplomatic mail – WASHINGTON 6, 11 July 1946

Hejaz unframed overprint in gold

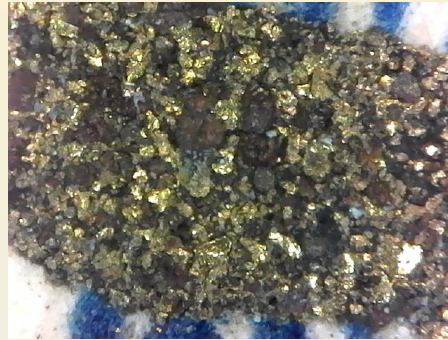


A typical example, but how many sheets were printed?

Position 39



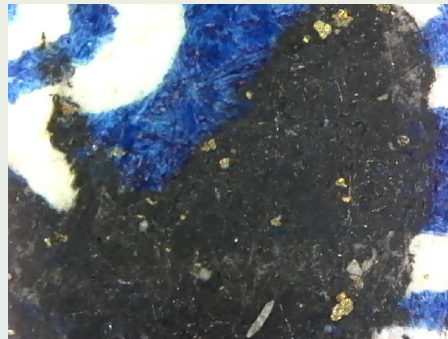
Under the microscope

A new discovery?

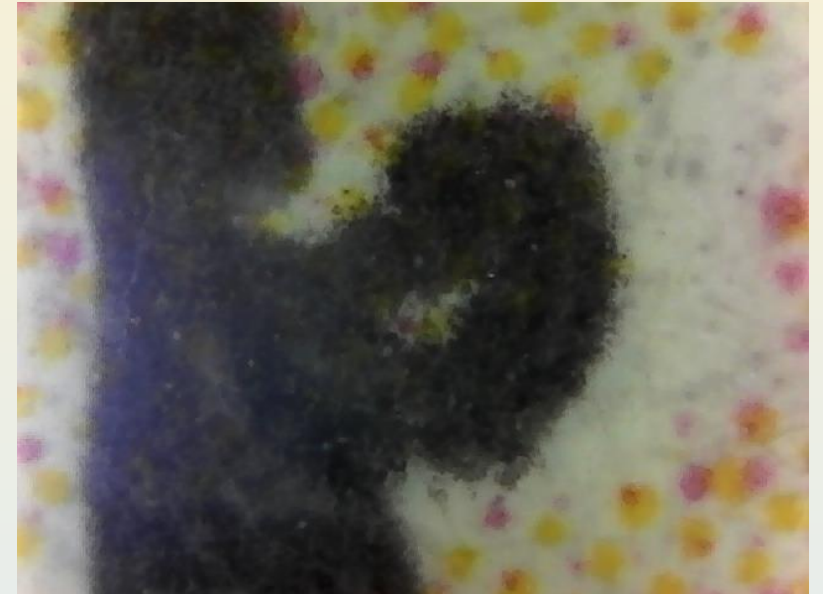
NO – a laser forgery
